Juan Jose holds a Pharm.D. and Ph.D in pharmaceutical sciences from the University of Valencia, Spain; and M.S. in biostatistics from the Autonomous University of Barcelona, Spain. He completed the internship and residency training in hospital pharmacy at Dr. Peset University Hospital, where later he held a Clinical Pharmacist position. For six years, he also served as adjunct professor of Pharmacokinetics and Pharmacodynamics at University Miguel Hernandez, Spain.

Juan Jose tenure in pharmaceutical industry started at Janssen Research & Development (JRD) in 2001, where he supported the oncology and hematology therapeutic areas for six years. In 2004, he received the prestigious Philip B. Hofmann Research Scientist award in recognition of his outstanding scientific leadership in model-based drug development of hematopoietic growth factors. Juan Jose joined Amgen in 2007 as a Director in the Pharmacokinetics and Drug Metabolism Department, and then became the head of the Applied Pharmacometrics Science group. In 2014, Juan Jose rejoined JRD, where he is currently leading the the Pharmacometrics Group in Europe and Asia within Clinical Pharmacology & Pharmacometrics at JRD. In this role, Juan Jose is accountable to provide Clinical Pharmacology and Pharmacometrics functional support to JRD portfolio.

Juan Jose has extensive experience in clinical pharmacology and strong understanding of application of M&S in drug development. He has published more than 100 research articles in peer-reviewed journals and book chapters in the PK/PD modeling and simulation in different therapeutic areas, including oncology, hematology, neuroscience, infectious disease, osteoporosis and vaccines. Juan is also a member of the Editorial Advisory Board of the Journal of Pharmacokinetics and Pharmacodynamics, and the Population Approach Group in Europe (PAGE) scientific organizing committee.
